Firstly, Happy New Year to everyone!

2015 has been a very busy year for Enigma-Gaming; we've grown to an insane amount of users daily now currently being 1,300~ daily unique users. We also had to upgrade to a 1024 slot license to account for the growth and times we regularly hit over 500 users concurrently connected.

There's been constant work on the website from a complete overhaul to the odd tweak/fix, the channel creation is much more staff friendly and is handling it's self in a more efficient way after 2 years of active development I feel it's finally in a near complete state.

I also created and released the new ranking system in its entirety in the matter of a single 12 hour period, while there may be a few people that don't like it. Overall I think it's been quite a success! I will soon create a checker so that you can easily see how many days you have rather than having to work it out from the date form that you see on TeamSpeak.

On a bigger note, our move to the new dedicated server was a large success after the removal of a specific community along-side we saw a drastic decrease in DDOS Attacks and the effects of them on the server. While occasionally we do get attacked and people disconnect, it's not usually for too long. We have however had a few issues with the network that we use across the globe in recent months but that's out of our control and hopefully won't occur too often!

I'd like to especially thank all the donators who have generously given money towards the cost of running Enigma-Gaming; it's quite a large amount per month to pay out of pocket so I appreciate the help very much!

The biggest thanks I can give has to go out to the staff that help me keep everything running smoothly so that I can still have a life alongside running this! Without these people managing the server we'd really be quite stuck with a huge amount of trolls.

Here's some interesting statistics for you:

1 Jan 2015 – Dec 31 2015: Our website was visited by 53,733 unique people with a total of 167,607 page views.

21 Sept 2015: Skype went down for a few hours, in this period we had 234 new channels created many of which were unable to connect due to us reaching the 512 server limit at the time.

Dec 31 2015: At this date our TeamSpeak database contains 11,862 unique users. (Inactive users are automatically deleted by TeamSpeak)
